ESTABLISHING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCEDURES FOR THE TOWN OF HAMBURG COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PREPARATION

WHEREAS, §66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that the Board of Hamburg adopts written procedures designed to foster public participation at every stage of a comprehensive plan preparation or amendment process, and that such written procedures shall provide for wide distribution of draft plan materials, an opportunity for the public to submit written comments on the plan materials, and a process for the governing body to respond to such comments; and

WHEREAS, the Town intends to use procedures to foster public participation, ensure wide distribution of draft plan materials, provide opportunities for written comments on such materials, and provide mechanisms to respond to comments by holding monthly Plan Commission meetings, public open houses, publishing newsletters and circulating them to town citizens and to provide for public comments for those who attend at least one public hearing on the proposed plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Hamburg Board hereby adopts this resolution in support of public participation in the Comprehensive Plan preparation process to ensure compliance with the requirements of §66.1001(4)(a), Wisconsin Statutes.
